The 150 years Anniversary will be celebrated widely in Norway and throughout the U.S.A.

In the period from October 5 to October 29, 1975, H.M. King Olav V will take part in a very extensive program which will take him from New York to Washington D.C., Minneapolis, Chicago, Seattle, San Francisco, Los Angeles, Anchorage, and back to Norway.

- 3:00 p.m.:** Meet the children at Norwegian Memorial Church.
- 8:00 p.m.:** Norwegian festival concert by Chicago Symphony Orchestra.

- 11:30 a.m.:** Luncheon at Ottawa, Ill. Presentation of the Sloop painting to the King of Norway.
